**Related Fields Courses**

In order to fulfill the related field requirement, you need to take 2 classes either from one department, or on a specific topic.

For instance, you can take 2 classes from the history department, from Chicano Studies, from political science. Or, you can take 2 classes on Asian-American culture--a history class on Asian-Americans and an Asian-American studies class. Another example: you can take 2 classes on ancient Greece--a history class and a near-east archaeology class.

Because of the nature of this requirement, most of these courses will not automatically appear on your DPR, so you may need to petition your related field classes. Please consult with an advisor.
